Project Context

The Background

The Commonwealth Educational Media Centre for Asia (CEMCA) catalysed and supported by Rashtriya Vigyan Evam Prodyogiki Sanchar Parishad (RVPSP), Department of Science and Technology, Government of India, New Delhi, has embarked on a pan-Indian project to evaluate and encourage understanding and application of science in everyday life for women. Entitled 'Science for Women' (SFW) this project aims to reach out to the women in the poorly literate and literary challenged sections of society both in the urban and rural sectors across the country. Through participatory programmes specially designed with specific issues of Nutrition & Health in focus and using the community participatory form of radio-programming, this project will study how best women can be introduced to the benefits of science in daily life. The project duration is at present two financial years and in the first phase, it is planned to operate through a selected number of Community Radio Stations (CRs) licensed to educational institutions and reach out to women living in communities covered within the primary and secondary catchment areas of these low power CR radio stations.

A pilot study for the project was conducted at Anna CR, Anna University, Chennai during the year 2004-2005. Eighteen educational institutions which had been granted the license to run community participatory radio stations were invited to a workshop held on March 8 and 9, 2007, under the aegis of RVPSP and at the end of the workshop each of the participating educational institutions was asked to submit proposals suited to develop the Science for Women Programme through

the community radio stations run by the institute.

CEMCA with its expertise in research, community participation and capacity building, was selected as the nodal organization and was asked to submit a comprehensive proposal to RVPSP for implementing and monitoring the project. CEMCA's role in the project is extensive - CEMCA is the focal organization for selection of educational institutions. It has been entrusted with the following responsibility:

- a) Help in identifying the communities and conduct a baseline study to profile the communities within the catchment areas of the community radio station
- b) Act as facilitator for capacity building within the students and the women from the communities so that the programmes developed can be truly community participatory,
- c) Ensure that the programmes are of interesting enough to motivate the women participating/ listening to understand the importance of science in everyday life
- d) Ensure proper utilization of the funds generated by RVPSP.

CEMCA has designed the implementation programme in two phases:

- The first phase consists of a baseline study conducted under the supervision of a CEMCA appointed expert using students from the educational institution and women from communities. Through this study a profile of the community is mapped, the current practices

and knowledge base vis-à-vis a range of issues/ subjects in the community documented and assessment made of the needs and shortcomings. The baseline study is also designed to motivate the students to understand and interact with the community women and develop awareness within the community about the CR channel run by the educational institution.

- In the second phase, workshops are conducted in the educational institutions for a capacity building exercise for the production team which will design and produce community participatory radio programmes with the central theme of Nutrition & Health. Community participatory programmes similar to the pilots developed in the Capacity Building Workshop will be produced regularly and broadcast from the channel daily from a date mutually agreed between RVPSP and the institute..
- Once the broadcasts have started regularly from the selected Community Radio channel, CEMCA will develop a methodology for evaluation of the project.

Fourteen Educational Institutions granted license to set up Community Radio Stations by I&B Ministry have been selected by CEMCA and RVPSP for awarding the SFW Project. The following report is the finding from the baseline study for KONGU CR Radio licensed to Kongu Engineering College in Perendurai, Erode Distt., Tamil Nadu.

Profile of KONGU CR

KONGU CR, the community radio is run by Kongu Engineering College in Perandurai, Erode District, Tamil Nadu. The broadcasts started from 7th August, 2005, on 90.4MHz over a radius of 15km, covering a rural population, essentially agricultural communities where literacy is low and health issues are vital.

The station was formally inaugurated by the former Vice-Chancellor of Madurai Kamraj University, Prof. S.V.ChittiBabu. Activities of the community radio station include regular visit by the production team to the villages, and the station encourages villagers to come to the radio station, understand how it works, and promotes student-community interaction. As Dr. K. Thangaraj, Coordinator of KONGU CR says, the focus

of the radio station is to encourage the community members to speak out their needs and ideas and learn to articulate their thought and grievances. This he feels is the first step towards development.

Baseline Study Objectives & Design

Objectives

The baseline study aims to achieve:

- Documentation of the socio-economic and demographic profile of the target listeners
- Understanding of the media habits of the women, with particular reference to Radio,
- Identify the issues of concern for the community
- Assess the willingness/interest among women for participation in the community radio initiative
- Build awareness for the Community Radio and SFW programmes

Study Methodology

Sample

The base line study was initiated from 29th November - 1st December 2007. There were 54 participants in all, most of them from the community. The institution sent 5 students and 8 faculty members of Kongu Engineering College. The community members at the workshop included women from Self-Help Groups, trainees from District Institute of Educational Training, housewives from village homes and women from community living near the college. The areas selected for the baseline study were as listed below:

- Nathakattupalayam
- Kasu
- Ellaimedu Chennimalai Road
- Perudurai
- V.Vellode
- Yallpalayam

All these villages (except Prundurai) are located within a radius of 7km from the Kongu College Campus and the signal of KONGU CR was clearly audible in all the homes during the survey. Perudurai is the urban area around the campus where the signals are very strong.

This was the second survey undertaken in Kongu. The first workshop and the survey following the workshop held earlier with Jai Chandiram had to be discarded as the database was found to be unsatisfactory.



Instrument

The questionnaire in Kongu Baseline Survey is marginally different from the questionnaire in other institutions as Ms. Jai Chandiram had decided to use the UNESCO developed Baseline Study format. As that questionnaire had been translated and printed in huge number, for the second baseline study under Mr. R. Mahadevan's guidance too the same questionnaire had been used. There is a difference in the thrust between the CEMCA developed questionnaire and the UNESCO questionnaire but most of the necessary information could be solicited.

The UNESCO questionnaire provides the following sets of information:

- a) Information on socio-economic profile of the community
- b) Media habits of the listeners- ownership, frequency of listening, interest, utility
- c) Information on issues like health hazards, family planning, social hygiene, childcare
- d) Profile of community women - education, marital status, size of family

Data Collection

Mr. R. Mahadevan was appointed by CEMCA as the local expert for conducting the 3-day Baseline study Workshop. The workshop was formally inaugurated on 29th November by Dr. K. Thangaraj, Coordinator for KONGU CR, who explained to the participants

the purpose of the workshop and how it would help in making the programmes from KONGU CR more listener-oriented. Mr. Mahadevan detailed out the procedure for data collection and the rationale behind the questionnaire.

A one-day introductory workshop was held prior to the data collection workshop to explain the need for a fresh data collection and where the volunteers need to be extra careful so that the data can be matched with the national tabulation system. During the workshop training was given through mock-interviews and tips were given on how to ask questions to obtain the exact information. All the students were told carry cameras and a field team was created for data collection, photography and cross-checking the data. This team included:

- i) 5 student volunteers who had some exposure to community participatory radio production.
- ii) Staff coordinators from Kongu Engineering College.
- iii) 40 community volunteers including members of local Self-Help Groups and trainees from the District Institute of Educational Training.

The participants were divided into 5 groups each consisting of one student, one staff member, two trainees for the district institute and three community women. The process of data collection was interactive. In addition, a team was formed under the guidance of Mr. R. Mahadevan, to process the data immediately so that at the end of the three-day workshop a detailed picture of the demographic character of the target audience/participant would emerge.



Data Analysis - Community Profile

The overall picture

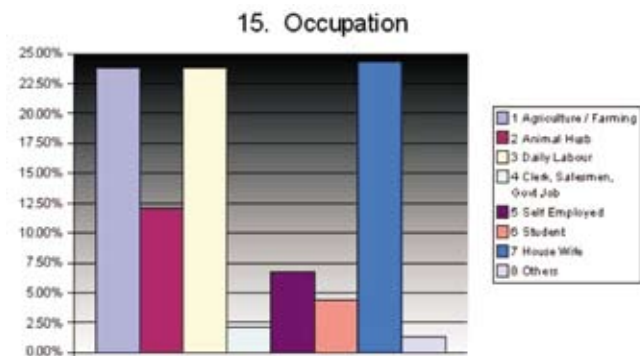
The total data is based on 613 respondents. Among these 77% were married women and nearly 625 in the

age range of 20-40 years. 4.1% of the respondents were women above the age of 60 years. The community is essentially Hindu (95%) with only 35 Muslim and 1% Christian found among the respondents. Despite being a agricultural community the education level among the women is encouraging. 48% women were literate and educated upto SSLC level. But over 22% were also found illiterate, showing wide gap in the socio-economic status of the community. A large number of women were daily wage workers (40.6%) and another 20% engaged in agricultural activities. 66% women reported that husband was the head of the family and lived in the house.

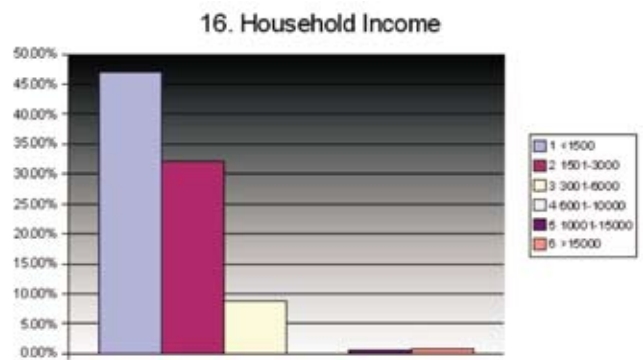
Socio-economic profile

The community is entirely rural with wide difference in the socio-economic conditions. The primary activity of the community is farming, with 40% working as agricultural hands.



More than 47% women belong to households earning below Rs. 1500 per month and only 21% had water connection in the house for drinking water. Over 50% of the women had to depend upon common water source like roadside tap or public hand pump for drinking water. However nearly 10% of the women reported monthly income in the range of Rs. 3001-6000 and an equal percentage of girls were students who did not have to participate in family earning. The community did not report any lack of employment opportunity for men or women in the area and were aware of the advantages of joining self help groups for improving their overall condition. The socio-economic diverges in the community was most starkly depicted in the kitchens - while 50% homes proudly displayed their LPG connection, over 32% admitted firewood as their only source of heat for cooking.

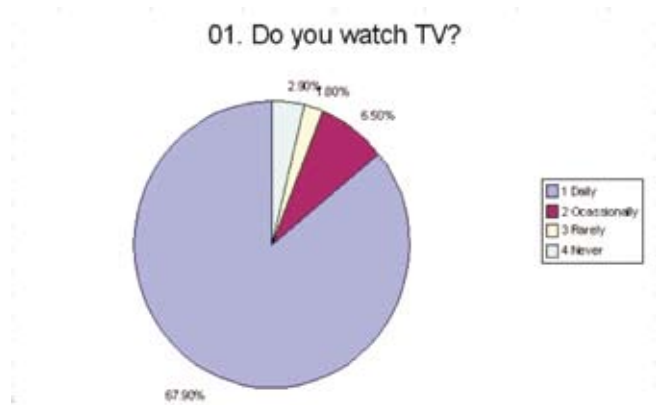

Lifestyle Indicators

76% of the homes had a radio with FM connection. Another 68% also watched television regularly. Beyond this no further information is available from the preset data available from the survey as the questionnaire did not solicit any information on life-style indicators. 34% of the women had private toilet facilities but 50% had to use open fields once again showing the extent of disparity in the region. Over 54% homes had an electrical grinder but only 6% had a refrigerator and 4% owned a washing machine.

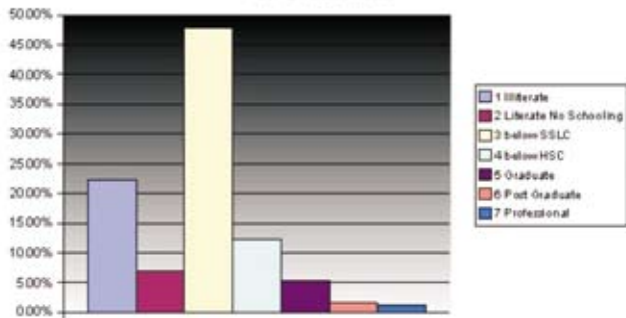


Condition of Women - literacy, education, status within family

As already indicated, a very large percentage of the women were literate (45.8%) and a few girls were educated above HSC (11.7%) as well. Over 37% were members of SHGs but another 50% said they had not heard about SHG indicating the wide gap in information, education and intra-social communication.

Primary issues of concern in community

Mosquito is a major problem as reported by 53% of women and Chikun - Guniya the most troublesome disease for 36% of the families. Pediatric health problem is another serious concern.

Primary issues of concern in household

The women are most concerned with improving the overall living standard of the family. They would like to learn more crafts through radio for overall improvement of living standards but need expert guidance. The family depends upon elders and neighbors as their source of information and support system.

Media Profile -ownership, consumption, needs

19% of the respondents reported reading newspapers daily while 22% never read any newspaper. Similarly 14% occasionally read magazines and 27% never saw any. The encouraging information was that over 76% owned radio with FM band and were regular listeners (64%). 70% also watched television daily. The usual listening hours are in the morning upto 10am and in the house. 15 said they were aware of KONGU CR. The community is able to pick up information through radio/Television news and informative programmes.

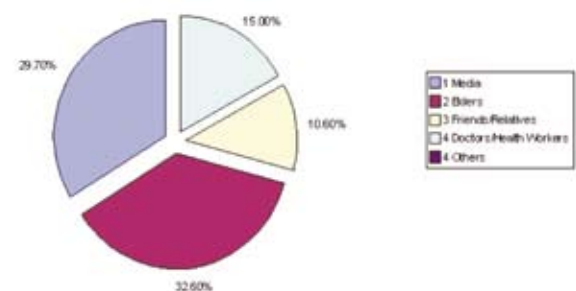
02. Do you Own Radio?



There is no special preference for any local dialect and the data shows on issues like family health, information on diet, on how adolescent children can be guided; epidemics and seasonal health concerns in addition to agricultural news are issues where media is considered a dependable source of information. 12%-28% respondents replied that they used radio as a source of information regularly.

Community participation in CR programmes

At present the community participation in KONGU CR programmes is very limited but 41% wanted to participate in radio programmes. The community felt more participatory programmes; especially interactive programme with experts will be useful. 30% also showed interest in radio presentation and another the highest interest was on programmes on agriculture (24%) and on traditional vocational training like tailoring, handicrafts food processing etc. .

Implications for KONGU CR

In the two sets of door-to-door survey, the volunteers met 1000 women face-to-face to build an audience for the KONGU CR. Thus a valuable asset was created for the CR station that can be tapped both for SFW and beyond as the database contains detailed information on the expectations from radio programmes, and the kind of programmes in which community is willing to participate.. During the course of the year, programmes with direct community participation should be designed and all these women invited to participate. Their presence in the programme will make the radio more relevant to its listeners.

Further, each of the surveyed household carries a bright coloured sticker, proclaiming the name of the channel KONGU CR, the frequency written in Tamil which will serve as a constant reminder to the community of the existence of KONGU CR. However the production team needs to keep in focus the following:

1. The socio-economic disparity in the community is very wide but needs and concerns are similar. Therefore it would be a challenge to make the programmes relevant to all sections.
2. Radio listening habits of the community as reflected in the data is a very encouraging. KONGU CR needs to involve community members on a regular basis to tap this asset and develop a sense of ownership with the radio station to become a constant source of information for everyone.
3. Group listening is and SHG activities already exist within the community. Therefore group participation in radio programmes involving experts will be a suitable format for KONGU CR.
4. KONGU CR will also have to devise ways of recording the women in their homes frequently as women seem to be partners in earning and may not find time to come for recording to the studio.
5. A suitable time for broadcast of the SFW programmes has to be worked out as the listenership is highest in the morning but concentration is on entertainment programmes. It is best not to go into competition with powerful entertainment channels but develop listening habit for SFW programme in a time slot in collaboration with SHGs and community members.
6. Findings & Gap Areas

For CEMCA and RVPSP, this survey threw up interesting contrasts in information.

- a. This community though living in a close geographical area and dependant on similar economic activity shows with socio-economic disparity. This must be kept in mind which planning for programmes.
- b. The community is literate and capable of absorbing information through media including radio.
- c. Regular information on child health, pregnancy, local health issues and seasonal precautions will benefit the community.

Recommendations of CEMCA

- A. The women from the community will only get into the habit of radio listening if they are regular participants in the programmes. Participatory production techniques are essential for the Science for Women programmes in KONGU CR.
- B. Community knows that radio is a dependable source of information. This is a very important asset for KONGU CR and participatory programmes planned with local information needs will make the radio channel popular.
- C. Community shows interest in interacting with experts. Programmes like phone-in, interactive question-answer sessions would interest the community women.

KONGU CR has some presence in the area but it is almost marginal. The programme planners need to keep in focus the community needs, involve a wide cross-section of the community members and devise programmes which are participatory.

There is already awareness within the community on the importance of radio as a source of information and KONGU CR needs to build on this available asset.

This report has summarised only the broad findings. Detailed tables in the appendix may be looked at for cross tabulations of habits and preferences with independent variables.

REPORT

The workshop on baseline study and content development for “Women & Child- Health & Nutrition” organized by CEMCA was conducted at Kongu CRS of Kongu Engineering College from Nov. 29, 2007 to Dec. 1, 2007. There were 54 participants in all including 5 students and 8 faculty members of Kongu Engineering College. Among the other 41 participants there were women drawn from the community around, representing Self- help groups, trainees from District Institute of Educational Training, housewives and others.

On Nov. 29, 2007, in the inaugural function, Dr. A. M. Natarajan, Principal, Kongu Engineering College presided and Dr. K. Thangaraj, Chief Co-ordinator Kongu CRS welcomed the participants. Mr. R. Mahadevan, the Consultant who conducted the 3- days workshop on behalf of CEMCA explained the purpose and procedure of the workshop. The inaugural function ended after introduction of the participants and trainers and vote of thanks by Dr. P. Thangaraj, another Co-ordinator of Kongu CRS.

Immediately after the function, the participants were divided into 5 heterogeneous groups, each consisting a student, staff member, and community women. The groups were named after leading women involved in Science, Health and Technology. The groups were named a) Marie Curie group b) Kalpana Chawla group c) Sunitha Williams group d) Muthulakshmi Reddy group e) Valentina Tereshkova group. Each group was advised to discuss separately about the type and title of the programme they would like to produce. They came up with 5 themes, i) The necessity of mother feeding ii) The impact on environment due to unhealthy toilet habits iii) The need for educating girl child iv) Girl Child and Family Planning and v) Dialogue on Status of Women’s Development.

Each group having identified their topics, were given training on how to record the programmes using the recorders, in terms of sensitiveness, place of recording etc... Mr. Satish Nagaraji explained and demonstrated the use of various types of recorders and how the facilities in the recorders can be effectively used for





recording and reproducing voices at different locations and surroundings.

The next day on Nov. 30, 2007, the members of the five groups were taken to different villages and locations where they recorded the opinions, suggestions and sufferings of the village community. The participants learnt a lot about the predicaments and sufferings of the villagers and also their desires, longings, and aspirations. It was a scintillating experience and revelation not only for the villagers but also to the participants. They returned from their fieldwork in the afternoon and each group presented to all the participants what they have recorded. There was a discussion about the content and how

it should be developed and presented. The trainers supplemented with ideas on how best the recorded information could be converted into a suitable broadcast material, by editing, introducing, adding expert advice and music where necessary and giving a final shape to the programme.

On the morning of Dec. 1, 2007, participants were introduced to the nuances of editing by Mr. Mahadevan and Mr. Satish Nagaraji. The participants of each group were taken to the studio and were given hands on training in editing and making the programmes presentable, interesting and informative. All the five groups produced presentable and very effective and

informative programmes which could be broadcast straightaway.

1st December being World AIDS Day, the participants were requested to come up with some slogans, poem etc. on prevention of HIV/ AIDS. Some very interesting slogans were read out during the Valedictory function in the evening by the participants.

The valedictory function started at 3pm on the third day in which Thiru A. V. Kumarasamy, Patron member of KVIT Trust and Correspondent of Kongu Polytechnic College delivered the valedictory address stressing the importance of maintaining the tradition and culture deep- rooted in the villages of India, through efforts of community radio. Dr. R. Jayanthi delivered a special address on the importance of participation of women in such programmes and how the self- confidence and temperament of women is given a boost by such workshops. Dean of Research & Development, Dr. M. A. Veluswami of Kongu Engineering College presided. Mr. R. Asokan, the technical co- ordinator of Kongu CR CRS welcomed the gathering and Dr. K. Thangaraj proposed a vote of thanks. The participants voiced their feedback about the workshop and spoke about the usefulness and need of such programmes. Dr. Sathyabanu, a member of the monitoring committee of Kongu CR CRS project on “Science for Women” and Mr. Damodaran, Principal of Kongu Polytechnic College

were present during the valedictory function. All the participants were awarded certificates of participation in the workshop and the function ended with the singing of National Anthem.

Every day during the workshop the participants were brought to the workshop from various places in and around and dropped back at their destinations in the evening. Coffee, snacks and lunch was provided to all the participants and trainers during intervals on all the 3 days. All the programmes including the inaugural and valedictory functions were compered, coordinated and presented by the participants themselves. For many of them it was a new experience.

A REPORT ON THE WORKSHOP ON THE ABOVE TOPIC CONDUCTED IN

KONGU ENGINEERING COLLEGE, PERUNDURAI
FROM 29 Nov.To 01Dec, 2007



The radio production capacity building workshop was inaugurated on 29th Nov. 2007 by the Principal of the college Dr. A.M. Natarajan. In his speech he emphasized the need to be “creative and innovative” to sustain listener interest in radio programmes. He thanked the Commonwealth Educational Media Centre for Asia for sponsoring this Science for Women capacity building workshop. He assured the management’s full commitment to the successful completion of the project.

Forty-one members from the in target area (Nathakkattupalayam, Chennimalai Palayam, and Rasampalayam), 8 lecturers and 5 students of the college attended the workshop.

PROCEEDINGS OF DAY1 (29.11.2007)

Mr.R.Mahadevan, Consultant, gave an informal introductory talk (rather a discussion with the members) on the differences between AIR, commercial CR broadcasters and the community radio. He made it clear that this is a unique experiment. The CR radio is for the community, by the community and of the community. Thus, the participation of the community

members in such large numbers (41) in this workshop was a good augury.

He then dealt with different formats of radio production and emphasized that simple straight format featuring actualities and interviews with community members form the back bone for most of the productions. The first format is straight talk and he explained to his participants, the advantages and disadvantages of this format. He then proceeded with Interview, Discussion, Question and Answer programmes and some of its variants like Quiz programmes and Phone-in programmes etc

After the brief introduction, the participants were divided into 5 groups with each group having a student and one or two lecturers and about 8 members of the community (that too from different villages). These groups were then asked to think about a programme relating to women & child health topics and take into consideration the human and material resources available to them. They were encouraged to come up with more than one idea. They were also asked to choose a format they think will be suitable for the idea.

In the afternoon session each group presented its idea and explained how they think they would go about the production. Each suggestion was analyzed by all the members and the experts. Finally, each group settled for a topic (Mother's milk, Girl's education, Sanitation & Hygiene, Nutritious food prepared by locally available grains & pulses etc). They were then informed of the baseline studies already done in this area and were requested to utilize them for planning programmes in future. For instance the most worrying health problem in the minds of the community seems to be 'Chikun Kunya', infection and next to it was provision of clean drinking water. Such topics should be taken up for the programmes involving the community, medical & health experts.

They were then introduced to the small hand held RC recorders of SONY (4 of them were available) and Mr. Satish Nagaraji who assisted the consultant on technical equipments, demonstrated how to record in the field, interviews etc. to best effect using these recorders. Then each group was given a recorder and were asked to practice recording and playing back. Surprisingly within a period of one hour the groups were able to record and play back (also they logged the file no, readings etc.). Mr. Satish then explained a few mistakes they tend to make and asked them to be careful to avoid them.

Day 2 (30.11.2007)

The participants were asked to go to the field (3 villages) and collect the basic recordings for the programme planned by them. Mr. Satish and the consultant accompanied different groups to the villages and helped them on the spot to get quality recordings. It was at this stage that groups needed maximum help as they were totally new to both software and hardware. On the spot they were taught interviewing techniques, positioning of the microphones and the general criteria for the selection of participants for the discussion etc. This exercise took little time but was very rewarding since they learnt in a practical way what to do and what not to do.

In the evening session the experience of the participants in the field was shared and every group got an idea what the other groups have attempted. The consultant pointed out the defects in terms of

selection of persons for interviews, discussions and some mistakes in the recording. He then demonstrated to them how to avoid them. The participants showed great interest and commitment to learn and so the session extended by more than an hour beyond the scheduled time.

Day 3 (1.12.2007)

In the first session Mr. Satish explained editing techniques in detail. The students who formed part of the groups were mostly familiar with the computer operations and as such easily understood the wave form editing which is akin to Ms Word. But others found it difficult as they didn't have basic knowledge of the computers.

After familiarizing of the participants to editing techniques they were requested to edit their programmes (3 editing tables were in position). With the help of professional editors (staff members) they got their programmes edited. Since the valedictory session was scheduled at 3' o'clock, the groups had only 2 hours to get their programmes edited. In future they may have to edit their programmes themselves was clearly told to them. The three staff members were requested to give hands on training in editing to group members in due course. Due to certain limitations of the editing machines 'under- fading' and 'up- fading' of background music could not be attempted. Notwithstanding this, the productions were fairly good and the programmes broadcast- worthy. Content wise they were rich. Special mention could be made of a programme, where in a first year student (Ms. Sriranjani) sang an excellent song depicting the trials and tribulations of a girls students coming from very poor family. The song was in the form of a letter written by a poor student to her mother who is a domestic servant in a village. It was very moving and fitted in with an interview independently recorded with a maid servant by another group. In this the poor mother in the village is struggling for existence and still was very particular to educate her daughter in a college had explained her story in full. The song and the interview perfectly meshed in drama and documentation. When this was played back in the evening valedictory session, all the members on the Dias, and the audience were moved to tears.



Valedictory session was presided over by the Thiru A. V. Kumarasamy, Trustee and Correspondent of a Kongu Institute. He promised all the help to the CR radio. The participants then spoke of what they learnt and how they felt about the crash course. Most of them felt that (as could be expected) the course is too short. But still they have learnt to record and edit programmes. The concepts behind the community radio that- it is for the community, of the community and by the community, was greatly appreciated by them. Judged by the assessment of the participants the programmes appear to have achieved its goals.

The Principal Dr. A. M. Natarajan and official coordinator Dr. K. Thangaraj spared no effort to make this workshop a success. Particularly Dr. K. Thangaraj attended all the sessions and sat right through and gave his valuable suggestions. He had provided comfortable working conditions for all the participants (he provided transport to the community members to come to the workshop and return facility also).

Mr. Satish gave very valuable inputs for the operation of hand held recorders and computerized editing techniques (SONY Digital Audio Software).
