**Sub: Change in schedule of the Second National Community Radio  
Sammelan- New Delhi.**

Sir/Madam

This is further to my letter of even no. dated 14<sup>th</sup> December 2011 wherein it was intimated that the Second CR Sammelan for functional Community Radio Stations of India is being organised **at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi from 13 -15<sup>th</sup> February 2012.**

2. Due to some unavoidable circumstances, the Sammelan dates have been rescheduled. **It will now be held from 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> February 2012 at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi.**

3. We request you to reschedule your travel tickets accordingly. The inconvenience caused is regretted.

4. I would also like to intimate you that, Ministry has decided to confer National Awards to best Community Radio Stations in India during the Sammelan. The awards will be in following categories:

- i) Thematic Award
- ii) Community Engagement Award
- iii) Promoting Local Culture Award
- iv) Most Creative/Innovative Programme Content Award
- v) Sustainability Model Award

5. Each category will have First, Second and Third prize of Rs. 50,000, Rs.30,000 and Rs.20,000 respectively

6. Nominations, along with the CD of programme in MP 3 format, may be sent latest by 30<sup>th</sup> January 2012 at the following address.

7. A Jury constituted by the Ministry will decide which stations deserve to be awarded. The decisions of the Jury will be final and binding and will not be reversed under any circumstances. The other terms and conditions will be as under:

- i) Each station will be allowed to send a maximum of two entries for any of the above.
- ii) Along with entry, CRS will have to send a programme schedule as proof of its broadcast (including the date of broadcast).
- iii) Entries in languages other than English and Hindi must be accompanied with a brief (150 words) translation/ summary in English/Hindi.
- iv) The Programmes in MP 3 format (between 10 to a maximum of 15 minutes) need to be sent either as a mail attachment or by Speed Post in a CD.
- v) The programme should have been broadcast by the Radio Station before last date of receipt i.e. 25<sup>th</sup> January 2012. Entries of programmes which are under-production will not be accepted.
- vi) For the Sustainability Award category, documentary proofs will be required in respect of (a) Source of funds, (b) Sustenance Model (c) Agency from where support was received. A description of innovative models will also be accepted for example, Government's grant-in-aid, projects and special services rendered etc.
